#### SUMMARY:

On October 18, 2022, the Disaster Relief Committee (DRC) voted to recommend to the Palm Bay Municipal a donation of \$1,500 to \$2,000 to Samaritan's Purse for the assistance to southwest Florida Hurricane Ian disaster relief.
